Whether you want to quickly and intuitively write down a few meeting notes, update a changelog, or simply edit pages, there is no faster and easier way to do it than with Diary for Confluence.

Just add the diary macro to your page and start writing entries. Did you find a typo in one of your entries? Use the in place editing feature to quickly fix the problem, or completely remove the entry by clicking the "Delete" button.

We want Diary for Confluence to be as accessible and useful as possible for everyone. Therefore, we allow you to customize the behavior and design of your diary according to your own needs. In the macro parameters, you can easily select the order in which your entries are to be displayed, where the editor for new entries should appear, whether the time should be displayed in your entries, and so on.
